Attachment #2: This page is a spreadsheet dated from March 8, 2014, to March 21, 2014, for the past ten non-culinary events along Las Vegas Blvd. between Russell and Sahara. The total cost is \$85,702.50.

Question #3: Does Metro exempt any groups from being charged police reimbursement costs for events? If the answer is yes, please list the names of which groups have been exempted.

LVMPD does not maintain a list of specifically named groups that are not charged reimbursement costs. It is our policy to not charge organizers of labor disputes. LVMPD must remain a neutral third-party in these disputes. An organized labor event can be treated and billed like any other special event if it is not a demonstration against a specific business.

Question #4: How much has Metro charged non-Culinary Union events held on the Strip in the month of January (2014) and in the month of February (2014)?

An addendum to this question was received via electronic mail on March 18, 2014, at 3:40 p.m. The addendum was as follows:

And, rather than providing information about billing of all non-Culinary Union events on the Strip for January and February, would you please just tell me how much Metro has charged for the past 10 non-Culinary Union events that were held on the Strip?
